

ELANUS NOTATUS. *El. oculis nigro anguste circumdatis ; fronte, lateribus faciei corporeque subtùs albis ; nuchâ, dorso, scapularibus, tectricibusque caudæ majoribus delicatè cinereis ; alis maximis ex partibus nigris, humeris subtùs albis ; primariis supra nigrescenti-cinereis, subtùs fusco-nigris ; caudâ cinerescenti-albâ ; rostro nigro ; cerâ pedibusque aurantiaco-flavis.*

Long. tot. unc. 14 ; *alæ*, $11\frac{3}{4}$; *caudæ*, $6\frac{1}{4}$; *tarsi*, $1\frac{5}{8}$.

Hab. in Novâ Cambriâ Australi.

Obs. Distinguished from *Elanus melanopterus* by the oval spot of black on the under surface of the wing, whence its specific name ; it also differs from *Elanus leucurus* in the form of the tail and other characters.
